



## Students can get a jumpstart on their BSHM

Students pursuing an Associate Degree in an Allied Health program with one of our alliance community colleges can get a jumpstart on their Bachelor of Science in Health Management (BSHM) degree at the University of Phoenix. Through our Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) your students can complete the following four upper division courses while finishing their Associate Degree at your college.

- **HCS/321** – Business Communication for Health Care Managers
- **HCS/325** – Health Care Management
- **HCS/370** – Organizational Behavior
- **HCS/335** – Health Care Ethics and Social Responsibility

These students are also eligible for our Tuition Guarantee Program which will freeze their tuition at \$350 per credit hour while they complete their BSHM program.

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### How it works

When students enroll in the CEP program they take classes at University of Phoenix between semesters at your community college. Students may begin after the first, second, or third semester and depending upon when they start, can complete up to 4 upper division courses.

CEP students are enrolled in courses with other associate degree completers, providing students a built-in support system. And upon completion, their associate degree will transfer into the University of Phoenix BSHM program under our current articulation agreement.

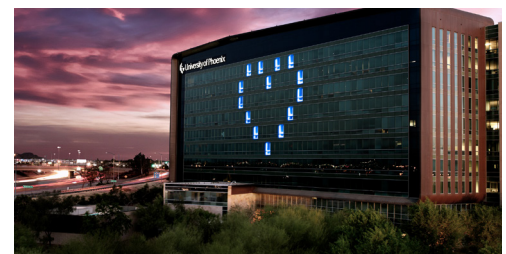
